Holiday art ideas...

Nature frames

You will need:

*Card *Sticky back plastic *Tape

What to do:

Use the card to create a frame and cover with sticky back plastic. Tape it down and then stick on any bits you have found from the garden/ trip to the park



Jelly fish sun catcher

You will need:

*card or sugar paper *tissue paper *sticky back plastic *ribbon

What to do:

Cut out a 'jelly fish body' shape and cover with sticky back plastic.

Tear up bits of tissue paper and stick them to the body. Add strips of ribbon as the tentacles.

Fly swatter painting

You will need:

*fly swatters *paper *paint *paint trays

What to do:

Put the paint in to trays and dip the fly swatter into the paint. Splat the fly swatter on to the paper to make different marks



Finger print rainbow trees

You will need:

* brown/ black sugar paper/car *paper *rainbow coloured paints *glue

What to do:

Using the brown/ black paper or card, draw around your open hand and cut it out. Use the paints to create a finger print rainbow. Leave it to dry and then glue the hand on top of the rainbow.





Water gun/ spray bottle painting

You will need:

* water gun or spray bottle *paper *paint

What to do:

Water down the paint in equal parts. Fill the water gun or spray bottle and then spray on to the paper. This works best when the paper is placed upright.

Shaving foam painting

You will need:

* shaving foam *paint *tray *paint brushes

What to do:

Squirt paint on the base of your tray and then cover it with shaving foam. Use a paint brush to mix the shaving foam and paint.



Ice painting

You will need:

*ice cube tray *paint/ food colouring *water *paper *wooden lollipop sticks

What to do:

Half fill the ice cube tray with water and add paint/ food colouring to each section. Mix using the wooden lollipop sticks, leave the sticks in and freeze. Once they are frozen, carefully remove each one and use them to paint a lovely picture.









String painting

You will need:

*paper *string *paint *trays or bowls

What to do:

Cut lengths of string and place them into the trays/ bowls of paint.

Move the string round to make sure it is covered in paint. Place on to

the paper and move the string over the page to create your picture.

Foil painting

You will need:

*tin foil *paint *brushes

What to do:

Pour paint over the foil and use a paint brush (or your fingers if you want to get messy!) to create your picture. You could practice writing letter, numbers, shapes etc.



Sandpaper colouring

You will need:

*sandpaper *wax crayons

What to do:

Get a strip of sandpaper and use the wax crayons to draw a picture.

You could use a marker pen to draw different lines to follow across
the page.





Shaving foam colour mixing bags

You will need:

*food bags *tape *paint *shaving foam

What to do:

In the corners of the bag, place two different colours of paint. Fill the bag with shaving foam and gently squeeze to let out most of the air. Secure the top using tape and squash and squeeze to mix the colours.

Googly eye sensory bag

You will need:

*food bag *hair gel *googly eyes *tape

What to do:

Fill the bag with hair gel and add in the googly eyes. Secure the top using tape and push the eyes around the bag. You could also raw on some faces and manipulate the googly eyes in to place.



Cling film art

You will need:

* cling film *paint *paper *tape

What to do:

Squirt paint on to the paper and place a piece of cling film over the top. Secure the cling film with tape and push the paint around to create your picture. Once you have finished, peel off the cling film and leave your picture to dry.



Marble rolling art



<u>You will need:</u>

*marbles *paint *paper *tray or box

What to do:

Place the paper in the box and squirt paint over the top. Place the marbles in the box and roll side to side, up and down leaving tracks.

Salad spinner art

Y<u>ou will need:</u>

*salad spinner *paper plates *paint

What to do:

Place the paper plate in to the salad spinner and squirt paint on to the plate. Cover the spinner and use the handle to spin it round.
