

Dear Parents/ Carers,

Following the updated government guidance relating to the prevention against Covid 19, we wish to reassure parents/carers that we will continue to follow all advice and recommendations from Public Health England and the Government.

There are NO plans to close the school/college currently, however please be assured the schools and college has an action plan in place in the event of any enforced closure.

Action plan

- Weekly welfare phone call by a member of staff to all pupils, if contact cannot be made with families this will need to be referred to the local authority.
- We have every intention to provide packed lunch or vouchers to students that are currently entitled to free school meals, this is depending on Government advice.

If you are needing, or choosing, to self-isolate whilst school remains open please can we request that you ring or email us once a week just to touch base. It is important to us that we remain these links.

We appreciate that things may feel uncertain so we wanted to put together a useful list of organisations that you may need to rely on in coming months. Remember to use smaller shops if you are struggling to find goods as we have found these tend to be less targeted by those who are 'panic buying'. Most importantly do not feel alone. We are here and will support each other as best we can. Please keep this information to hand and use it when needed.
