Our approach

How outreach works

Outreach works best when our staff and yours work closely together, with a clear focus on building expertise in your setting. Our aim is to support the professionals already working with the child, and the targets they have already set, building capacity, confidence and sustainability so that provision for pupils with SEND is fully inclusive.

What to expect

**Get in touch**

Complete the outreach referral form at the back of this brochure and email it to us.

**Initial observational visit or meeting**

Once we receive your referral, we arrange a visit to your setting.

**Advice, support and training**

We work alongside your staff, providing advice, modelling, programmes and recommendations.

**Follow-up and review**

Further visits, depending on the package you choose.

**Please note**

Outreach is not intended to be a remedial intervention, a stepping stone in the EHCP process, or a pathway for admission to a special school.

Outreach packages

Level 1

Initial observational visit to your setting or for your pupil to visit Fox Wood, providing advice and support. A written report will be provided based on observations and recommendations.

**Training in your setting**

Any course can run at your setting, for example on an INSET day. Travel costs are added to the fees. Bespoke training is available.

Our services

Our services in detail

Every service can be delivered on its own, or combined into one of the outreach packages.

IN-SCHOOL SUPPORT

School visits, advice and guidance, in-lesson support

A trained and experienced SEN teacher can visit your setting and provide personalised advice and guidance to your staff, for example how to set up a visual timetable, how to differentiate activities, or how to assess a pupil in a specific area. They can also provide in-lesson support for the pupil and staff if required.

Observations, feedback and written reports

A trained and experienced SEN teacher can provide observations, feedback and written reports to help you address barriers to learning, and can support your action planning in response to their recommendations.

Assessment support

An experienced teacher can support your staff to develop assessment techniques for individual pupils working below age-related expectations. This could include baseline assessments, developing Individual Education Programmes, using assessment packages, and moderation.

Curriculum design and innovation, teaching and learning support

Experienced teachers and curriculum leaders can support curriculum design for individual pupils or whole groups, and help staff bring the curriculum to life through structured teaching and learning strategies.

COMMUNICATION AND AUTISM

Support with communication: Makaton, Intensive Interaction

As a communication and interaction specialist provision, we can provide skilled staff to work with you on personalised support packages for pupils, for example creating a Communication Passport, functional Makaton, Intensive Interaction, and sharing record-keeping ideas so you can show progress over time.

Autism: sensory needs, awareness and autism-friendly environments

Fox Wood is a National Autistic Society accredited school. A highly trained specialist teacher can visit your setting to give individual advice, or deliver training on autism awareness, sensory needs and creating an autism-friendly environment.

Visual resources and structures

We can provide a range of visual resources and structures to meet individual needs, for example a visual schedule for the school day, or a lesson structure that helps pupils understand what is being taught. You are welcome to visit Fox Wood to see them in practice.

Occupational Therapy

Our qualified Occupational Therapists can offer support and advice for individual pupils, for example helping staff write a sensory profile, sensory diet or Ready to Learn programme. Assessment and review prices are in the training menu.

They can also deliver bespoke courses for your staff and support you to create a whole-school approach.

Team Teach Level One

One day (6 hours)

Team Teach provides an accredited training framework for behaviour support, with an emphasis on building relationships, de-escalation, and reducing risk and restraint. Training is built on 95% positive behaviour support and de-escalation, and 5% physical intervention and risk reduction.

Our tutors develop shared values, attitudes, skills and knowledge, including verbal and non-verbal communication, diversion and de-escalation, and safe, effective physical interventions where appropriate, along with positive listening and learning.



Our tutors teach the same approach we use every day at Fox Wood, where Ofsted judged attendance and behaviour **Exceptional** in May 2026.

What the course covers

- All the theory-based practice within Team Teach: values, functions of behaviour, communication, stages of distress and support, the conflict spiral, and reacting versus responding
- Low-level responses, guides and prompts
- The small child module or one-person interventions

Team Teach provides an accredited training framework for behaviour support, with an emphasis on building relationships, de-escalation, and reducing risk and restraint. Training is built on 95% positive behaviour support and de-escalation, and 5% physical intervention and risk reduction.

Level Two covers the specific strategies and interventions needed for your workplace. Tutors also support the development of behaviour documentation, reporting and recording, and give staff the confidence to respond to a range of situations calmly and effectively.

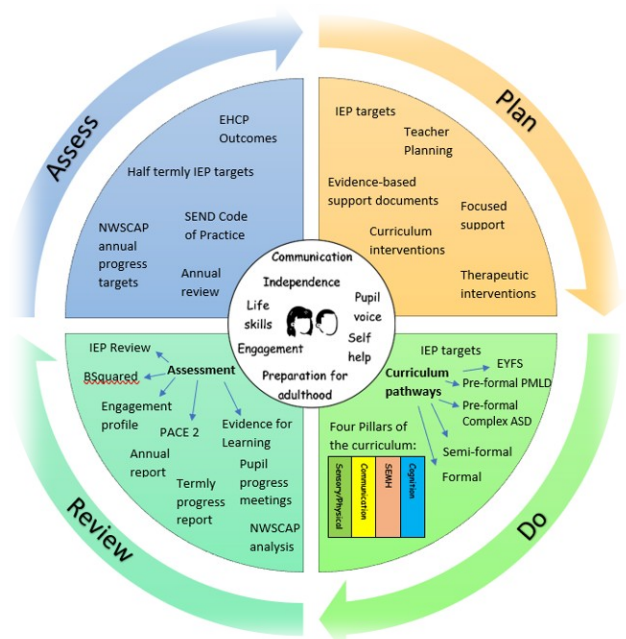
